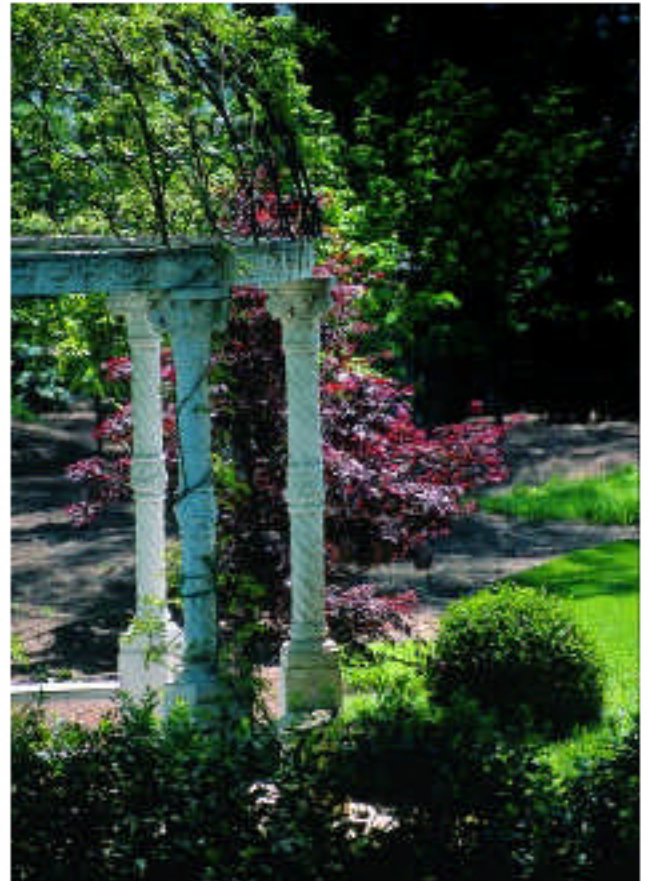


This 92-acre estate sits at the foothills of the Ozarks in the Mississippi delta. The Estate showcases a series of well organized gardens including the Renaissance Garden, The Cold Garden, the Japanese Garden, the Sculpture Garden and many more including a true English maze and rose garden.



Southern and European gardens influenced the design of this expansive estate. Arbors, urns, and sculptures dot the landscape and lawns to establish view corridors and respites designed to replenish the soul.



Tom Flowers was commissioned to design and develop the gardens spanning over 7 years. The challenge of establishing a physical plant complete with the greenhouses and training staff in horticulture and maintenance methods were required to achieve the gardens in this environment.
